



Massachusetts Association of Dairy Farmers Scholarship Rules and Information

The Massachusetts Association of Dairy Farmers (MADF) will award (one) \$1000.00 scholarship to a graduating high school senior who has been accepted at a College, Junior College, or to a College Student who is already enrolled. The student or their Parents or Guardian must be a member in good standing of MADF.

The top application will be notified by the chair of the MADF scholarship committee.

The MADF scholarship committee will review all applications and make its award based upon *academic achievement, extracurricular involvement, community service* and the quality of the original *essay* submitted with each application.

The *essay* should be about what the dairy industry means to you, your experience within the dairy industry and/or your goals for the future; in five hundred (500) words or less.

Application, letter of acceptance at your college you will be attending, transcript of grades at high school or grade record of the college you are already attending, essay and recommendations must be received by the Chair of the Scholarship Committee by April 1st, as one package. All applications must be complete when submitted. We are sorry, but late applications cannot be considered!

All applications submitted to MADF will be answered by mail after judging

All application materials are considered Confidential, and will be limited to examination for their intended purpose only and become property of MADF.

Please read carefully the following rules and information:

- 1 One (1) \$1000.00 scholarships will be awarded.
- 2 The student's Parents or Guardians must be a member in good standing of the Massachusetts Association of Dairy Farmers (MADF) for the year.
- 3 All applications must be sent complete with all paper work to MADF Scholarship committee, Rena Sumner, P.O. Box 384, Conway, MA 01341 on or before April 1st.
- 4 All scholarship awards will be payable after January 1st; provided that the student is still enrolled at the same college or university.
